QUALITY CONTROL/QUALITY ASSURANCE CERTIFIED ASPHALT TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

INTRODUCTION

This course is designed to give the participants a working knowledge of the principles associated with testing and controlling hot mix asphalt mixtures, aggregate properties and the test methods for each. Those who complete this course should have the "know-how" to meet all specification requirements for testing and controlling hot asphalt mixture for Quality Control/Quality Assurance specifications.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Although the course will have wide application because of the subject matter, it is designed for personnel who must be certified for Quality Control/Quality Assurance Specification projects. Accordingly the participants will be drawn from hot mix asphalt firms, aggregate firms, testing laboratories, consulting firms, state and local agencies.

PROGRAM CONTENT

The program content is designed to provide personnel with technical as well as practical knowledge through classroom sessions and "hands on" laboratory experience, which will be necessary to meet the requirements of the Quality Assurance Program. The four day program will be divided into classroom sessions, laboratory sessions and testing. In order to become a certified asphalt technician, you must become qualified in the tests of the Qualified Laboratory and Technical Program. See your District Materials and Test Engineer for program details.

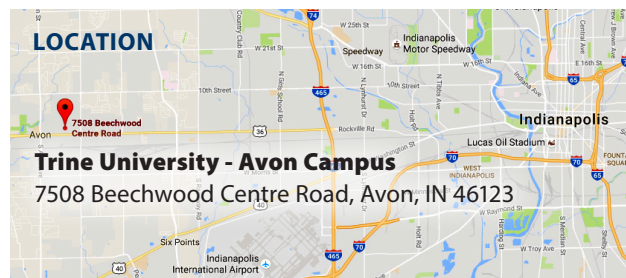

FEES

\$695 for members and all government agency personnel, including INDOT employees. All employees of non-member firms will be charged **\$795** per person. The class fee covers the student manual and the Texas Instruments scientific calculator provided to all students. All meals are the responsibility of students. APAI does not accept credit cards. Each organization will be invoiced by Greenwalt CPAs and all fees are to be paid by check made payable to APAI prior to the beginning of the first class on January 17, 2017. Registration is limited to 40 individuals due to laboratory space limitations.

There is no cancellation fee up to 15 days prior to the first day of the course. After that, a \$100 cancellation fee may be held.
