



Gohmann Asphalt & Construction, Inc. Wins National Award for Quality in Asphalt Paving

Lanham, MD - The National Asphalt Pavement Association (NAPA) announced today that Gohmann Asphalt & Construction, Inc. of Clarksville, Ind., has won a 2011 Quality in Construction Award for excellence in construction of an asphalt pavement. The company received its award at a special ceremony during the association's 57th Annual Meeting in Palm Desert, Calif.

The Quality in Construction Award recognizes asphalt pavements of excellence. "NAPA selects the recipients of its paving awards using a known set of standards that have been shown to give a good result," commented Kim Snyder, 2011 Chairman of the NAPA Board of Directors. "This award demonstrates the high quality of work that Gohmann Asphalt & Construction, Inc. is achieving." Gohmann Asphalt & Construction Inc. won the award for the reconstruction, widening, and overlay of I-64 in Louisville, starting at I-265 east 4.38 miles to just west of the Jefferson-Shelby County line. The company laid two new lanes of asphalt pavement in the median, then overlaid the existing traffic lanes. The challenge was to reconstruct the road while maintaining two lanes of traffic in each direction. The company occasionally paved at night due to the short project schedule. Gohmann Asphalt and Construction used warm-mix asphalt on most of the project, a paving material that requires less fuel to produce and reduces greenhouse gas emissions.
